#### Act to Adapt:

Here are instructions for printing and laminating.

### Adaptation Cards:

- 1) Print this Word docx [Single Sided].
- 2) Laminate each card.

# **Climate Hazard Cards:**

- 1) Print this PDF [Single Sided].
- 2) Print on the backside the climate card descriptions docx
- 3) Laminate each card.

#### **Example Resource cards:**

- 1) Print this PDF [Single Sided].
- 2) Laminate the page
- 3) Cut out each of the 30 cards.

## **Capacity Resource Cards:**

- 1) Print this PDF [Single Sided].
- 2) Laminate each card.
- 3) Cut along dotted line.

## **Climate Impact Pellets:**

- 1) Print this PDF [Single Sided] on recycled paper. Make sure it is scaled to 100%. Alternatively, just take old newspaper and fold it up and cut out strips of similar size
- 2) Cut out each rectangle on the paper. These rectangles do not need to be exact just approximate. The fastest way to do this is to cut out the 6 columns, stack them on top of each other, and then cut out the rows.
- 3) Crumple these into pellets (or let the players do this).
- 4) These pieces can be collected and reused.

#### Number Cards:

- 1) Print this PDF [Single Sided].
- 2) Laminate each card.

**Map:** Preferable use the hazard map of the community. If there is not already a map of the community, either use the example map or follow the

'GoogleMapInstructions.pdf' to print a satellite image of the community.

For the example map, you can use the file 'Example map projection' to project the map as power point on the screen. Or print out the 'Example Map' file and it stick on the wall:

- 1) Print this PDF [print single sided] preferable in A3 (A4 is ok too)
- 2) Laminate each card.
- 3) Tape the pieces together to make one big map (1-3 first row, 4-6 second row, 7-9 bottom row)
