Floodwaters were observed by satellites in the intervention region by November 19th.

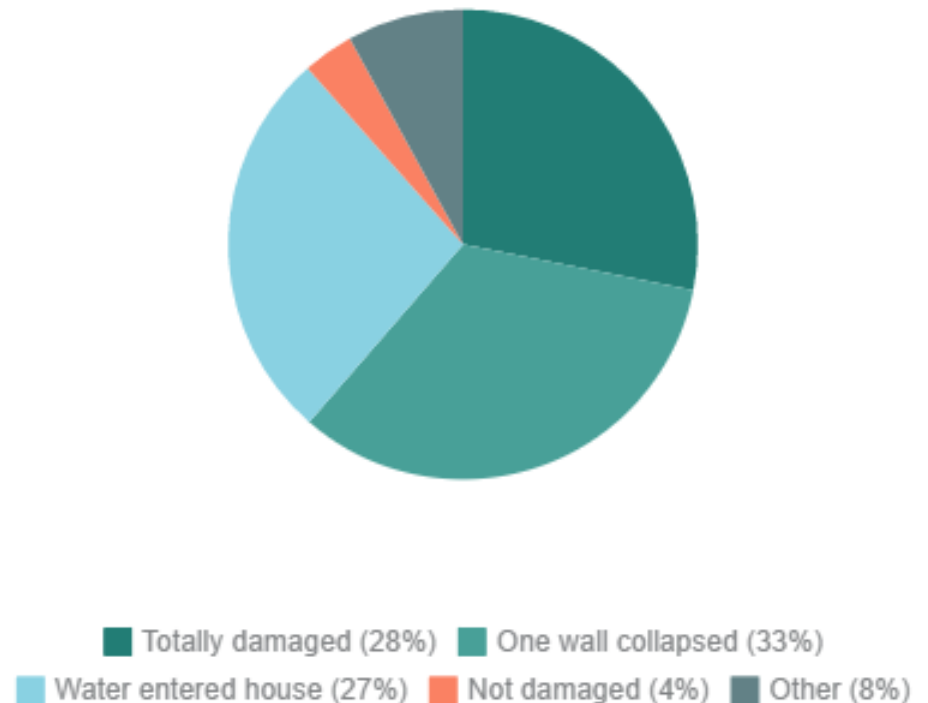


EVALUATION RESULTS

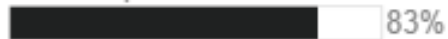

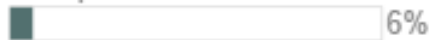

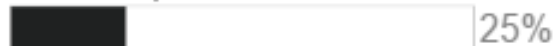
